

Roger Welch Memorial Scholarship

Purpose:

This award shall be established by the friends of Roger Welch to assist an eligible student in the CTE carpentry program with educational and/or vocational expenses upon graduation.

Administration:

The recipient shall be selected by Parkside Career Technology Center Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship Award:

An award of \$250 and an individual commemorative plaque will be presented to the recipient.

Eligibility:

- Student Earning a Scholastic 3.0 GPA or higher in Carpentry Course during his/her Senior Year
- Student that Displays a Professional Attitude
- Student with Satisfactory Attendance

Application:

To apply, students complete an application in the Parkside High School CTE Guidance Office and submit it by March 31 of his/her senior year.

Selection:

The recipient will be chosen by the Parkside CTE Scholarship Committee

Award:

The award (check and commemorative plaque) will be presented to the recipient at a meeting convened by the CTE Supervisor and members of the Roger Welch family.

Funds:

Funds to support the award will be generated and maintained by a committee composed of and established as *Friends of Roger Welch*.
