What do you want to be when you grow up?

We have all been asked this question at one point or another. The better question might be: How are you going to gain the skills and knowledge to enter your dream career?

Wicomico County Schools, in partnership with the Maryland State Department of Education, have developed an exploratory summer camp to help students entering sixth and seventh grade to begin mapping out the pathways to their future careers.

Areas of Exploration

During CEEC, students will explore a diverse group of future career clusters, which may include:

- ◆ Health & Human Services (Early Childcare, Culinary Arts, Nursing)
- ◆ Criminal Justice and Homeland Security
- ◆ Construction (HVAC, Masonry, Electricity, Carpentry)
- ◆ Engineering (Manufacturing and Design, Computer Aided Drafting & Design, Computer Science)
- ◆ Automobile Services (Mechanical Diagnosis & Repair, Collision Repair)

Who is Eligible?

Students who are rising sixth or seventh graders, have been diagnosed with a documented disability and have a current IEP or 504 plan are eligible for participation in CEEC.

Camp Location, Dates and Times

Where? CEEC will be held at the Parkside Center for Career and Technology Education, located at 1015 Beaglin Park Drive, Salisbury, Maryland, 21804.

When? CEEC will take place in one of two sessions for the student. Session One will take place June 24—28, 2019. Session Two will take place July 8—12, 2019.

What Times? CEEC will begin daily at 8:00 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m.

How do I get there? Transportation will be provided by Wicomico County Schools.

Lunch? Student will need to bring a lunch each day. Students of financial need may qualify for a free, provided lunch.
