Week of October 19th

→ Prekindergarten attends 4 days a week (except Wednesdays), full day (Delmar ES half day).

Week of October 26th

→ Kindergarten hybrid, students attend Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.

→ Students receiving Special Education services at school since 10/5 go to hybrid, full day Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.

Week of November 9th

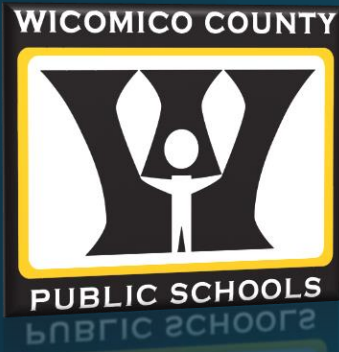
→ Grades 1 & 2 hybrid, students attend Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.

Week of November 30th

→ Grades 3-5 hybrid, students attend Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.

→ Begin a full day **virtual** bell schedule (every day but Wednesday) for middle school students in preparation for transition to full day hybrid in schools on Jan. 4th. Note: Mardela and Choices middle school students will remain on the current virtual schedule.

Parents/guardians commit to hybrid learning for student or select virtual learning through Jan. 29, 2021.

Week of January 4th

- Grades 6-8 (including Choices and Mardela) begin attending hybrid, Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday. Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.
- Begin a full day **virtual** bell schedule (every day but Wednesday) for high school students (including Choices and Mardela) in preparation for transition to full day hybrid in schools on Feb. 2nd.

Week of February 1st
(Second semester begins)

- Grades 9-12 attending hybrid Feb. 2nd (including all Choices and Mardela students). Learning continues virtually Wednesdays and on days student doesn't attend in person.
- All other grades except Prekindergarten continue with hybrid schedule of Monday/Tuesday or Thursday/Friday, with students learning virtually when not attending in person. Prekindergarten attends every day but Wednesday.

Parents/guardians commit to hybrid learning for student or select virtual learning.

GETTING READY

- Several weeks before a grade returns, parents/guardians choose hybrid for student or continued virtual learning
- If hybrid is selected, school told if student will use school bus
- Students assigned to hybrid group by household, school, transportation needs, etc. to ensure physical distancing
- Parent/guardian provides completed and signed COVID-19 Parent/Guardian Agreement prior to student attending or boarding school bus
- Teachers/staff members in school one week before students

SCHOOL DAY

- Students bring laptop and charger to and from school each day when attending in-person
- Meals eaten at student's desk or in cafeteria with physical distancing - desks/tables disinfected before and after meal
- Meals available free of charge for all students for school year
- Students learning virtually in hybrid when not attending in person
- Wednesdays - asynchronous learning for all

HEALTH & SAFETY

- Masks worn from arrival through dismissal and on school bus by students and staff
- Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer
- Physical distancing of 6 feet or more whenever possible
- Procedures followed for disinfecting classrooms and other areas throughout day and every night
- Plans in place for handling COVID-19 or COVID-19-like cases among students or staff
