

Instruction returns to virtual for all students of Wicomico County Public Schools, from the end of the day November 17 through the end of the day December 18, due to COVID-19 numbers in the community.

The plan is for hybrid, in-person instruction to resume the week of January 4th (Prekindergarten-Grade 8), if community health metrics have improved. High school students would return for in-person hybrid learning the week of February 2nd. Wicomico County must have 7 consecutive days with a positivity rate below 5% AND a new case rate below 15 for schools to reopen as planned.
