## FOURTH CIRCUIT SPONSORS 2019 HIGH SCHOOL ESSAY CONTEST

The United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit is sponsoring an Civics Essay Contest for students in Grades 9 through 12 in Maryland, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia, and West Virginia, with cash awards of \$2,000 (first place), \$1,500 (second place), and \$1,000 (third place) for the top essays. Essays are limited to 1,000 words and must be submitted by April 15, 2019. Winners will be announced in July, and travel will be provided to the court's Constitution Day event in September 2019.

This is the third year the Court has sponsored the contest. Award winners are celebrated at a ceremony in September. Please encourage your students to take advantage of the opportunity to participate in this Contest either independently or as part of classroom activities.

This year's essay question is: "How has the right to freedom of speech established for public school students in the Supreme Court case of Tinker v. Des Moines evolved in the 50 years since it was decided?"
