SMART Club Interest Meeting

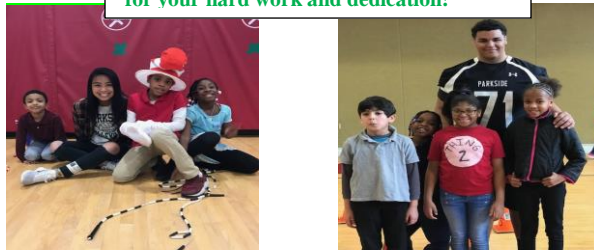
