Art Club

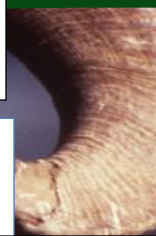

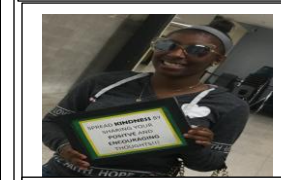
