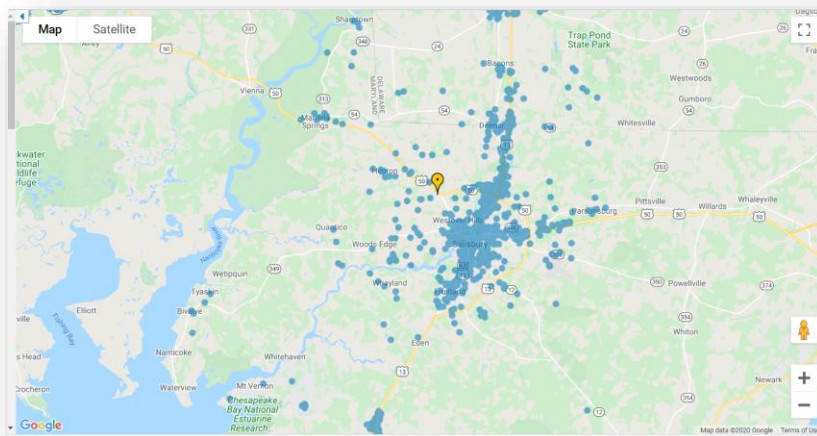


Use this document to logon to the free Comcast Xfinity Wi-Fi Service and access the internet from your Windows-based device.

Note that Comcast-Xfinity has made this service available at no cost, until **December 31, 2020**. Service may not be available or of high speed in all areas of the Comcast footprint
(Mac users – follow your process for accessing wireless networks)

1. Check to see if a Comcast Xfinity wifi is in your area
 - a. Go to: <https://hotspots.wifi.comcast.com/>
 - b. Enter your address, city, or zip code in the Search field (top-left). Click **Go**. You should see a map like this, with location dots showing wifi. Zoom-in for your street. If your street appears to have service, proceed to step-2. Otherwise, please contact Comcast.

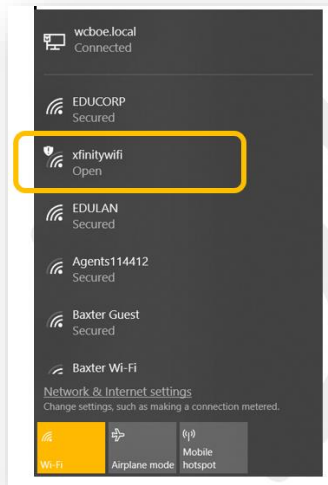


2. Connect to the wireless access tool in the Windows system tray (lower-right portion of your screen), next to the Clock. Click on the rainbow-looking icon.

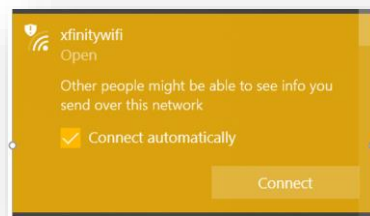


3. A pop-up menu will appear. Click to select the **xfinitywifi** network item:

4. Click the (optional) checkbox for **Connect Automatically**. Then click the **Connect** button.



5. When you open your browser Comcast Xfinity may present you with a webpage to read and accept the **Terms** for you to use their free service. **Please read the terms**. If you agree with the terms, click the appropriate button to accept the terms. Terms are between you and Comcast, not Wicomico County Public Schools.
