EVIDENCE OF LEARNING TIMELINE ASSESSMENT DESCRIPTIONS

Advanced Placement Tests (AP) – Provides students earning a qualifying grade on one or more AP Tests the opportunity to be awarded credit or advanced placement by thousands of colleges worldwide.

CogAT – Online assessment of cognitive abilities test administered to students in grade 2.

Diagnostic and Summative Writing Assessments – Online assessments designed to identify the writing strengths and weaknesses of students in grades 6-12

Early Fall Assessment (EFA) – The Early Fall Assessment is a shortened version of our MCAP ELA and Math assessments given to students in grades 4-9 in the fall of 2021 as an ESSA requirement. Results will be used to determine instructional needs and gaps that may have occurred do the pandemic.

English Language Proficiency Test (MCAP ELP – ACCESS) – Assesses English language proficiency for students who do not speak English or have limited English proficiency.

High School Assessments (HSA) – An end of course test including 4 units per content area that assess both school performance and individual student performance in the areas of life science and government.

I-Ready Assessments – Ongoing county-based ELA online formative assessments administered in grades K-12.

Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) – An assessment for all kindergarten students that measures school readiness across four domains: Social Foundations, Mathematics, Language/Literacy, and Physical /Motor Development.

MAP Growth – Ongoing online formative math assessments administered to grades K-12.

Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) – MCAP is the overarching umbrella for MD state testing that will allow students to demonstrate their skills and knowledge in English/Language Arts and Mathematics These assessments measure student achievement in English/Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics based on the learning standards contained in the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards (MCCRS) for grades 3–8 and high school.

Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) Social Studies 8 - An assessment of Middle School United States History and grade 8 skills and processes.

Maryland Integrated Science Assessment (MISA) - A measure of student achievement in science in grade 5 (testing content from grades 3-5), grade 8 (testing content from grades 6, 7, and 8) and end-of-sequence assessment in high school.

Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) ALT ELA/MATH AND MISA - A test in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science for students, grads 3-11, with significant cognitive disabilities who are unable to participate in the traditional assessments.

Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) – Measures verbal reasoning skills, critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills, and writing skills and provides firsthand practice for the SAT. Scores are used to qualify students for National Merit Scholarship Corporation’s (NMSC) Scholarship programs

Scholastic Aptitude Test/ Reasoning Test (SAT) –Measures critical reading, writing, and mathematical reasoning skills students have developed over time. Typically taken by high school juniors and seniors.

A student who knowingly causes, allows, or is otherwise involved in the presentation of forged, counterfeit, or altered identification for the purpose of obtaining admission to a test administration site for any of the tests listed on this schedule card shall have the test results invalidated, and shall be ineligible to retake the test until the next official testing opportunity and may be subject to other disciplinary action. A student who knowingly engages in any activities during testing which result in invalidation of scores shall be ineligible to retake the test until the next official testing opportunity and may be subject to other disciplinary action.
