(You will not be able to register if twelve "tickets" have already been issued. If you are able to register, you are one of the twelve, provided you also complete the COVID Parent Agreement and are up to date with all state required immunizations).

Please note the following procedures that we will be enforcing:

- Students must arrive on time and wait in their car until an administrator or teacher comes out by the E-Wing entrance to let them in. Students will not be admitted late. No exceptions.
- Students must wear a mask that covers their mouth and nose while in the building for the entirety of the session.
- Students will practice social distancing. Students must stay in their assigned desks during the tutoring session. They must seek permission from the teacher to get out of their seat for any reason.
- Students must bring their fully-charged laptop.
- Students must bring content-related questions and materials to work on for the hour that they are with the tutor.
- Students must remain in the tutoring session for the full hour.
- Students must have a ride available at the school at 10:00 a.m. and 12 p.m. Students should report directly to their cars upon exiting the building rather than congregating and socializing.
- Failure to report directly to their car at the end of the tutoring session, or violating rules above will forfeit the student's right of participating in future tutoring opportunities.
