Campus Parking for Students

Below are the procedures for obtaining a student parking permit and the regulations for parking on the JMB Campus.

- There are limited parking spaces available.
- Parking permits and privileges are limited to **JUNIORS** and **SENIORS** only.
- Parking passes **WILL NOT** be issued to SOPHOMORES.

Permit Requests

- 1) **Submit Request to your School Counselor, along with your Late Arrival and/or Early Dismissal form(s) before February 2, 2021.**
- 2) Students will not be guaranteed a permit if their application is not submitted within the given time frame. Parking passes will be issued on a first come, first served basis.
- 3) Space permitting, parking permits will be issued after the deadline. Students who obtain a driver's license or car during the year or other circumstances that prohibited the student from applying for a permit in the beginning of the school year will be able to apply for a permit. Applications will be considered on a case by case basis and availability of spots.

Permit Procedures

- 1) **STUDENTS MUST PRESENT A COPY OF THEIR VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND REGISTRATION CARD ALONG WITH THE COMPLETED APPLICATION to obtain a parking permit.**
- 2) All vehicles parked during school hours must be registered.
- 3) Permits must be placed on lower left windshield (inside driver's side).
- 4) There will be **no fee** for a parking permit for the 2020-2021 School Year.

Campus Parking Procedures

- 1) Upon receiving a permit, **students may park in the designated student parking area only**, which is the lot between the school and auditorium. Students **are not** permitted to park in the Staff Parking Lot.
- 2) All drivers must follow the traffic patterns in the entrance/exit driveways of the student parking lot. Drivers must observe all traffic signs.
- 3) Speed limit on campus is 10 mph.
- 4) Drivers must park upon arriving on school grounds. **"Driving around" is not permitted.**
- 5) **Upon arrival to school, all occupants must exit their vehicle immediately and proceed into the building.**
- 6) Students must obtain permission from an administrator, as well as be accompanied by an administrator or campus patrol, to go to one's car throughout the school day.
- 7) **Students are not to park in the ONLEY ROAD PARKING LOT, it is designated for BUSES ONLY throughout the school day. Student Athletes are only allowed to park in the Onley Road Parking Lot after 3:00PM.**
- 8) Students in the Work Placement Program, Teacher Practicum, or who are authorized to leave school before the regular dismissal are not permitted to take other students off school property without appropriate authorization.
- 9) If a student is using more than one vehicle, the permit must be transferred. If no permit is displayed, the driver will be subject to receive a parking violation.

General Parking Rules and Consequences

- 1) **Permits are to be displayed as of February 2, 2021. Current school year's permit should be visible at all times thereafter.**
- 2) Any student found leaving school without permission will have his/her permit revoked for 30 days.
- 3) Safety is our first concern. Reckless driving of any type will result in the immediate loss of parking privileges.
- 4) Students are expected to fully cooperate with staff members supervising parking areas. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action and loss of parking privileges.
- 5) Drivers are responsible for the actions of **ALL** passengers in their cars.
- 6) There is to be **NO SMOKING/E-CIGS/VAPING, ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION or The Use of Other Drugs** in cars while on school property.
- 7) Any student parking illegally or not abiding by the rules will be subject to the following consequences:

**Failure to adhere to the above expectations would result in an appropriate consequence based on the Wicomico County Code of Conduct.*

James M. Bennett High School reserves the right to revoke any parking permit for violation of school rules and regulations with regard to the safety and courteous operation of a motor vehicle on school property.

Parking on campus is a privilege. This privilege can be removed as a part of disciplinary actions taken by the principal or her designee. Students who park on school property without a parking permit or who park in unauthorized areas are subject to disciplinary actions.

James M. Bennett High School and Wicomico County Board of Education assumes NO Liability for any damages to vehicles or theft of items from vehicles parked on school property. Any incident involving a private vehicle is to be reported to the Salisbury Police Department or the Wicomico County Sheriff's Office immediately following the incident.
